6th Annual Medieval Graduate Student Symposium

The keynote speaker is Professor Jean Givens from the University of Connecticut. The title for the keynote address is "Medieval Art and the Wonders of Nature: The Strange Case of the King's Elephant." Jean Givens is Professor of Art History. Her research centers on medieval England and France, the history of visual and verbal literacy, and design initiatives in twentieth-century Denmark and Sweden. She has published two books. *Observation and Image-Making in Gothic Art* (Cambridge, 2005) was awarded the 2009 John Nicholas Brown prize by the Medieval Academy of America. *Visualizing Medieval Medicine and Natural History, 1220-1550* (co-edited with historians of science, Karen M.
