

University Writing Awards Competition Announcement for 2010-2011

The University Writing Committee is seeking faculty nominations of student writing for this year's University Writing Awards. Nominations will be welcomed for the following categories: Undergraduate Scholarly Prose (\$325); Undergraduate Creative Prose, Fiction or Nonfiction (\$325); Undergraduate Poetry (\$325); Graduate Scholarly Prose (\$500), Graduate Creative Prose, Fiction or Nonfiction (\$500); and Graduate Poetry (\$500). All submissions must be accompanied by the attached Form of Nomination and signed by the nominating faculty member. Below are specific guidelines:

- The pieces submitted must have been written between January 1, 2010 and December 31, 2010.
- Students must have been enrolled full-time or part-time during at least one long semester of the 2010 calendar year.
- Submissions may be as short as a single page and as long as 20 pages in each category.
- Students may submit in more than one category.
- All work must be double-spaced, with 12-point Times New Roman font, 1-inch margins, page numbers in upper right-hand corner with the student's name and the title of each work on a separate Name and Title page.
- Each submission must be accompanied by the attached Form of Nomination.
- Submissions must not have won previous awards or have been accepted for publication by a student or professional journal.
- Students must own copyright of their work prior to submission.
- Students must submit four hard copies of each submission, five hard copies if the submission is poetry, to Wooten 162 (Faculty Senate Office) by **4:00 p.m. on Monday, January 31, 2011**.

Winners will receive their awards at the Honors Day ceremony on April 8, 2011.
