- Studio/Design majors **must** submit a portfolio of work. Work may be presented via disk or url. Work submitted on a CD should be submitted in digital Powerpoint.
- Printed, full-color contact sheet(s) (thumbnails) of their works.

## DISK

If you choose to submit a portfolio of your works on a disk, please follow these instructions:

1. Make sure your CD is a **dual platform disk** (can be viewed on a Mac or a PC) and comes with accompanying printed, full-color contact sheets (thumbnails)
2. Your works must be in jpeg or gif format and can be presented as a Power Point presentation. Disks should be protected in a CD sleeve to avoid damage to the disk which could render it unreadable. *Please check your disk to make sure it is readable by a computer other than the one on which it was created.*
3. You must submit 6 to 20 works in your portfolio. Please do not submit more than 20.

If you choose to submit a URL address for viewing of your artworks, please make sure:

1. There are at least 6 to 20 works available for viewing.
2. Your works must be in jpeg or gif format.

**\*\* Reminder applicants that choose to submit a URL must still submit a printed, full-color contact sheets (thumbnails) along with their application materials.**
