**IN ORDER TO CHANGE YOUR STATUS FROM PRE-MAJOR TO MAJOR YOU MUST:**

Complete at least 30 hours of college courses (includes those listed below) and:

- a. Complete ART 1200, 2350, and 2360 with a grade of C or better;
- b. Have at least a 2.5 GPA on the required Art courses;
- c. Have a minimum 2.0 UNT grade point average;
- d. Complete the Art History Entrance Event.

**ENTRANCE REQUIREMENT FOR ART HISTORY MAJORS**

Students planning to major in art history must complete the Art History Entrance Event during or after their last semester of the Art Appreciation, Art History Survey I, and Art History Survey II sequence of classes. The Entrance Event will be administered during the early part of the Fall and Spring semesters. Upon completing the Entrance Event, each new art history major will be assigned a tenured or tenure-track faculty mentor who will complete the degree plan with the student. The Entrance requirement will not discourage or prohibit interested students from majoring in art history. Students **will not**, however, be allowed to make a degree plan for an art history major without completing this requirement and will not be able to register for the required Methodologies (AEAH 4800) and Senior Seminar courses (AEAH 4848) without a degree plan on file.

**CAPSTONE COURSE FOR ART HISTORY MAJORS**

Art History majors must successfully complete Senior Seminar (AEAH 4848) in order to graduate. Students must have successfully completed Art History Methodologies (AEAH 4800) in order to register for Senior Seminar. Like Senior Seminar, Methodologies is offered in Fall semesters only.
